The 17th Annual Wine & Cheese event is a celebration of all the women that have carved their way in their industries and of the future generation of women that will continue to do so.

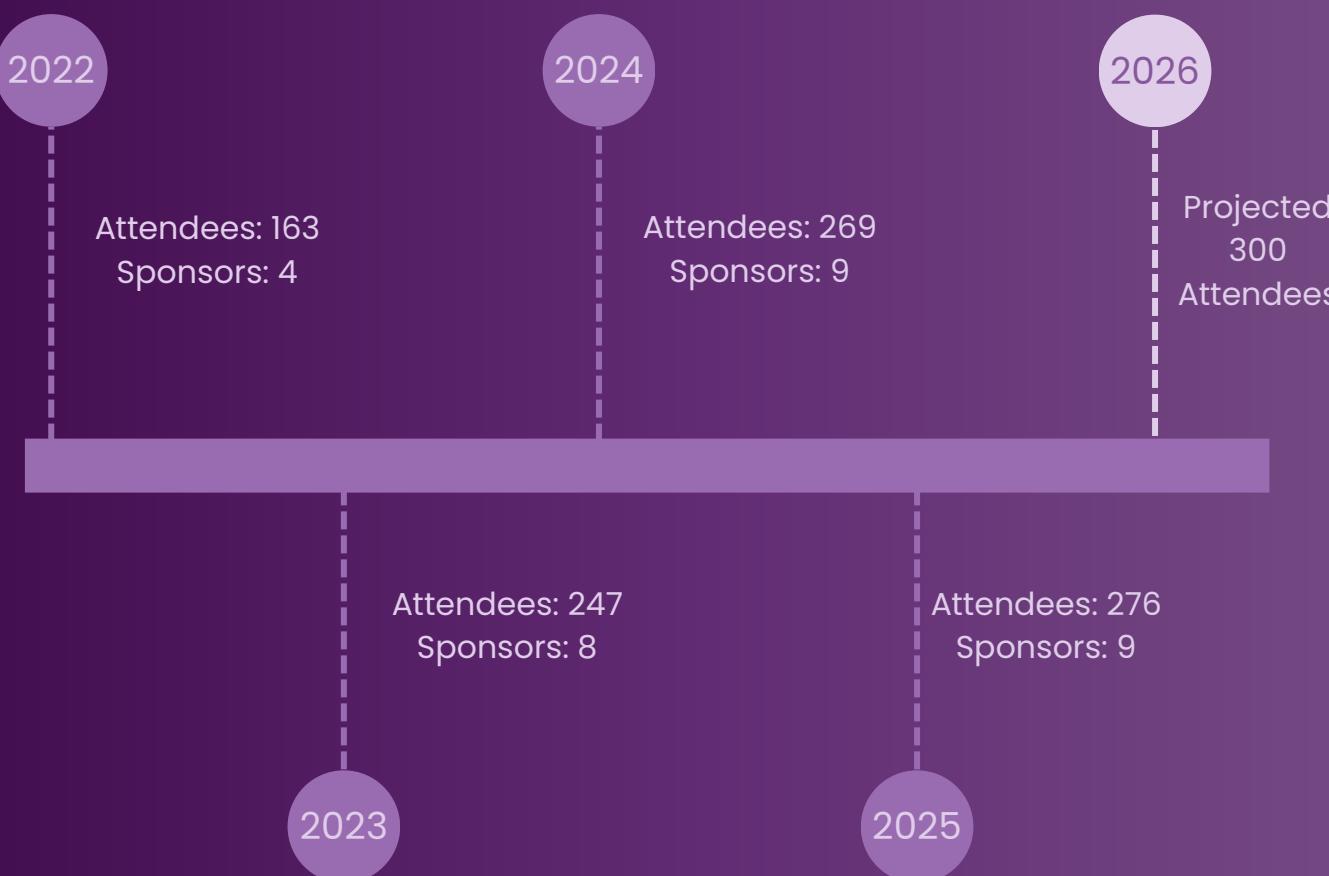
Wine and Cheese provides an opportunity for individuals in engineering and STEM to expand their network and spark valuable discussions in a low-pressure environment with others.
